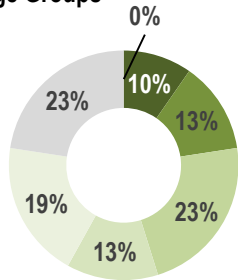

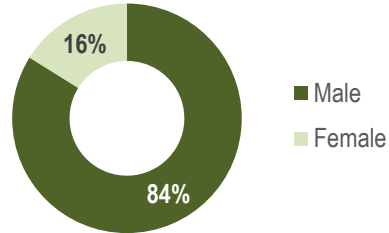

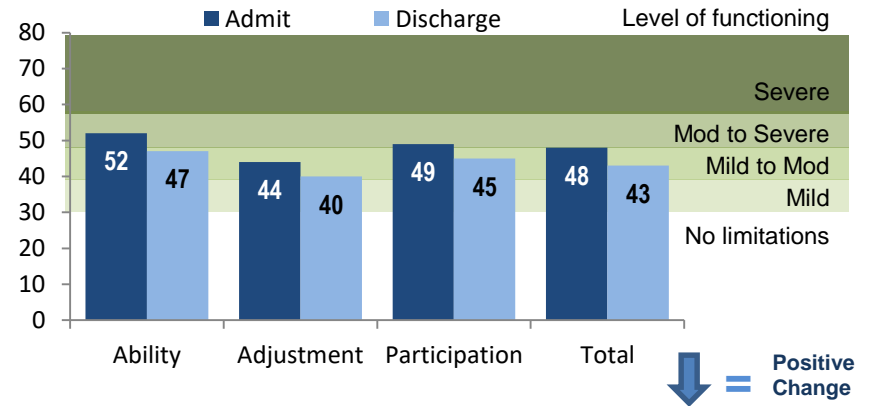

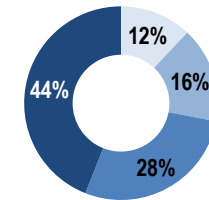
Outcomes*

Overall Improvement Mayo-Portland Adaptability Inventory (N=24)



Patient Employability (N=25)

Patient employability as measured by the Disability Rating Scale at the time of discharge.



- No restrictions on return to work
- Could work at selected jobs
- Could work at sheltered workshop
- Not employable

Supervision Needs (N=28)

Measured by the Supervision Rating Scale at the time of discharge.
